About Us

The German Academic Exchange Service (DAAD), with financial support provided by the Federal Ministry for Economic Cooperation and Development (BMZ), supports academic qualification measures for individuals from developing countries who participate in the In-Country/In-Region Programme. Every year, the DAAD awards more than 700 BMZ-funded scholarships to junior researchers from Africa, the Middle East, Latin America, South East Asia, and South Asia to help finance their Master's or Ph.D. programs in their home country or region.

The program aims to enable trained professionals to address and deal with diverse societal, economic and ecological issues in developing countries. A further objective is to sustainably improve the teaching and research conditions in the partner regions and to strengthen their higher education profile.

As an additional offer for scholarship holders of the In-Country/In-Region Programme, the DAAD cooperates with German universities in organizing a range of summer schools in Germany. These measures allow the students and young researchers to take part in high-class academic training in a selected subject area, meet and exchange with peers from across the world, and make their own, unique experiences of German society, culture, and history.

The IDEA Summer School is exclusively targeting DAAD scholarship holders in the In-Country/In-Region Programme. Participants are advanced students at the Master's or Ph.D level in all disciplines from developing countries. The IDEA Summer School is especially valuable to those who have an interest in setting up their own business or implementing their own ideas as development or knowledge transfer projects.

Eligibility Criteria

- Applicants are active scholarship holders of the DAAD's In-Country/In-Region Programme as of 1st January 2023.
- ✓ Applicants should hold at least a **Bachelor's degree**.
- Active and excellent English language skills (speaking and writing) are indispensable as the language of communication in the summer school will be English. If you are not sure about your level of fluency and/ or the suitability of your documents, please contact the coordinators.
- ✓ High personal **motivation** and willingness to get actively involved during the training sessions are expected from the participants.
- ✓ The provision of **international experience** is an asset.
- ✓ Please note that attending this summer school should not compromise your regular study programme commitments or duration. This summer school will not be accepted as justification for extension of your current In-Country/In-Region scholarship.



The program aims to achieve a fair gender balance among the participants. Further, it is foreseen that the group represents a balance of Master's students and Ph.D. candidates. People with disability are explicitly encouraged to apply!

Please mind that participation is possible only once. You may apply to up to two DAAD summer schools in 2023. However, participation will only be possible in one of them.

Program Content and Aims

The IDEA Summer School aims to enable you to plan and implement your projects for knowledge transfer. Therefore, the project ideas are at the heart of the Summer School. We will focus on three channels of knowledge transfer: Innovation, Entrepreneurship (business idea development) and Teaching.


Based on the three channels the Summer School allows you to emphasize one of those tracks by submitting a respective project idea with the application. One intensive coaching day per week in Leipzig supports you to advance the project based on the input of the respective week. Each of the tracks aims to empower you to develop your own project idea further as a direct output of the Summer School.



Check the <u>call for</u> <u>application website</u> and get the most recent information. We strongly recommend to pay attention to the general advise on applications provided here.



Register in our <u>Innolytics</u> <u>platform</u>. You will be assigned manually to the IDEAS Application Area by the IDEAS Team. This may take some time but this additional step is to avoid unintended access to your idea.



Fill the <u>application survey</u>. The details are required to coordinate the application process with DAAD and the other SP/DL Summer Schools.



Log on to Innolytics and fill in the details of your idea. Take time to do this very carefully. The idea, the presentation of your personal capacity and your motivation statement submitted here is the basis for the selection process.

Once you have completed those steps you can await the result of our selection process. Please be patient with us, we need some time to do this since we want to treat your application with the careful attention that it deserves.

The selection will be based on the quality of the project idea (innovativeness, feasibility and impact), the expected value addition through SEPT throughout the IDEA Summer School and the credibility of the applicants capacity to implement the project. Formal quality of the application will also play a role. The selection committee, comprised of high-profile higher education management experts and staff of DAAD, meets in March and the selected candidates will be informed about the results of the selection meeting by the end of April 2023.
